For example, donors will have chances to learn about related activities in target communities and other parts of the world, and grantee organizations will have a forum for sharing innovative methodologies.



## A World of Giving Options

You have the flexibility to customize grant activities based on your preferences. Here is a brief summary of how each organization with our alliance helps donors achieve their giving goals.

- **The Resource Foundation** (Central and South America and the Caribbean) works with donors to identify projects that meet their philanthropic objectives. Donors may support projects managed by nonprofit agencies that they have identified, or choose from TRF's network of leading nonprofits. For example, through The Resource Foundation a high-profile donor established a Subfund to maximize the effectiveness of her philanthropy. One of the projects that she has been able to support through the Subfund is an orphanage in Caracas, Venezuela, that offers schooling, medical and psychological care, recreational activities and adoption/family reinsertion services, all in a safe and loving environment.
- **The King Baudouin Foundation United States** (Europe and Sub-Saharan Africa) enables US donors to reach out to European charities that protect children on-line, spotlight the next generation of great musicians, pass on the memory of the Holocaust, or preserve historic sites, to name a few examples. In Africa, KBFUS donors support local initiatives that train health professionals, develop sustainable sources of income for communities affected by HIV/AIDS, or place orphans in foster homes. If they don't have a favorite organization in mind, we can help donors identify premier non-profit organizations in a given country, region or field.
- **Give2Asia** (Asia) helps donors recommend funding for a specific organization, such as an alma mater in China or India, and to start new programs. For example, one donor who wished to fund a new family medical clinic in Afghanistan has been responsible for creating new services in a community that would otherwise have lacked adequate health care for women and children. Some donors also join with others to support common causes, such as the more than 2,000 contributors to Give2Asia's Tsunami Recovery Fund. Staff and advisors in 18 Asian countries administer all Give2Asia grants.

Each organization also actively collaborates with professional advisors, community foundations and donor advised funds, and provides them with the tools they need to enable their clients to expand their giving to foreign horizons.
